## Application 14/00733/MAJOR

- New Local Plan must explicitly rule out additional development at Hook.
- Hart must bring forward or fully support proposals for suitable facilities at Hook for a population of 10,000
- Vital that the Major Sites Subcommittee has public input for this case given the premature state of this application right now
- Zebra or other controlled crossings needed on B3349 and
  A30 at this site for safety and integration with rest of Hook
- **Bypasses** to the east of this site and to the south of Hook to resolve traffic issues
- School vehicular access revision for 20% growth
- Whole village traffic review and enforcement of existing access-only estate roads
- Provision or subsidy of **bus services to reduce car reliance**
- Ensure sewage system can cope with the cumulative developments using the upstream link

Detailed analysis and mitigation in light of **Environment Agency** comments on **flood risk and drainage**
